*Action Items from the Fall 2008 Committee Meeting*

December 16-17, 2008  
Lombard, Illinois

*States:*

Let Tim Runyon know if they want to send someone to Argonne for a training session in June 2009 (Tim will send Lisa the dates).

Let DOE's Joe DiMatteo know if they are interested in TEPP exercises and training in 2009.

Provide ideas to Lisa Janairo for TEC agenda topics as soon as possible.

Tim Runyon will send Jon Schwarz, Laura Dresen, and Lisa Janairo booklets explaining the Illinois pilot study.

Kevin Leuer and Melanie Rasmusson will work with Lisa Janairo to compile detailed comments on the proposed TEC agenda.

Kevin Leuer will check his availability to attend the NEI Dry Storage Information Forum (with Melanie Rasmusson as backup). *(Note: Kevin cannot attend.)*

*Lisa Janairo:*

After receiving DOE's letter on TEC, prepare a draft letter (working with other regions?) to react to the proposed changes.

Draft a letter to DOE commenting on transportation aspects of the GNEP draft programmatic EIS.

Read the West Valley Decommissioning EIS and share information with the states.

Check on the status of CVSA's letter to DOT regarding the need to make MCSAP funding available to cover the required CVSA Level VI inspections.

Prepare draft letter to DOE explaining the region's reaction to the plan for stakeholder interaction, asking for clarification, and being specific about the response expected. Incorporate the committee's key issues into the letter to clarify the region's intentions.

CSG Midwestern Radioactive Materials Transportation Committee  
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Confirm with Earl Easton that he will be able to arrange an NRC security briefing for the states and, if so, whether it will be limited to just committee members.

Add to the committee's Section 180(c) comments a reference to staff time for planning being a covered expense. (*Note: Kevin has provided language.*)

Update the committee roster to show Melanie Rasmusson as the new junior co-chair for 2009.

Survey the committee members regarding dates (late May, all of June) for the next committee meeting as well as possible interest in a tour.

Distribute Ella McNeil's talking points with other follow-up materials.

Send Brady Lester's wife a sympathy card on behalf of the committee.

Check with Earl Easton about Melanie Rasmusson's suggestion that the committee present to the commission annually (similar to what the CRCPD does).

Schedule phone call with other regions to develop new "menu" for the OCRWM cooperative agreement.

Develop new project brochure in 2009.

*Julie Offner:*

Check on the intent of the annual OCRWM meeting in DC – that is, can the regions send more than two state representatives?

Send the proposed TEC agenda as a Word document to Lisa Janairo and Cort Richardson.

*Bill Mackie:*

Send Lisa Janairo the list of Midwestern recipients of the 8-week rolling schedule and where they'll fall on the new distribution list. Lisa will distribute, and the states will give feedback.

*Earl Easton:*

Raise to the NEI forum organizers the topics of risk communication and the viability of long-term interim storage on site for the 2009 Dry Storage Information Forum.
